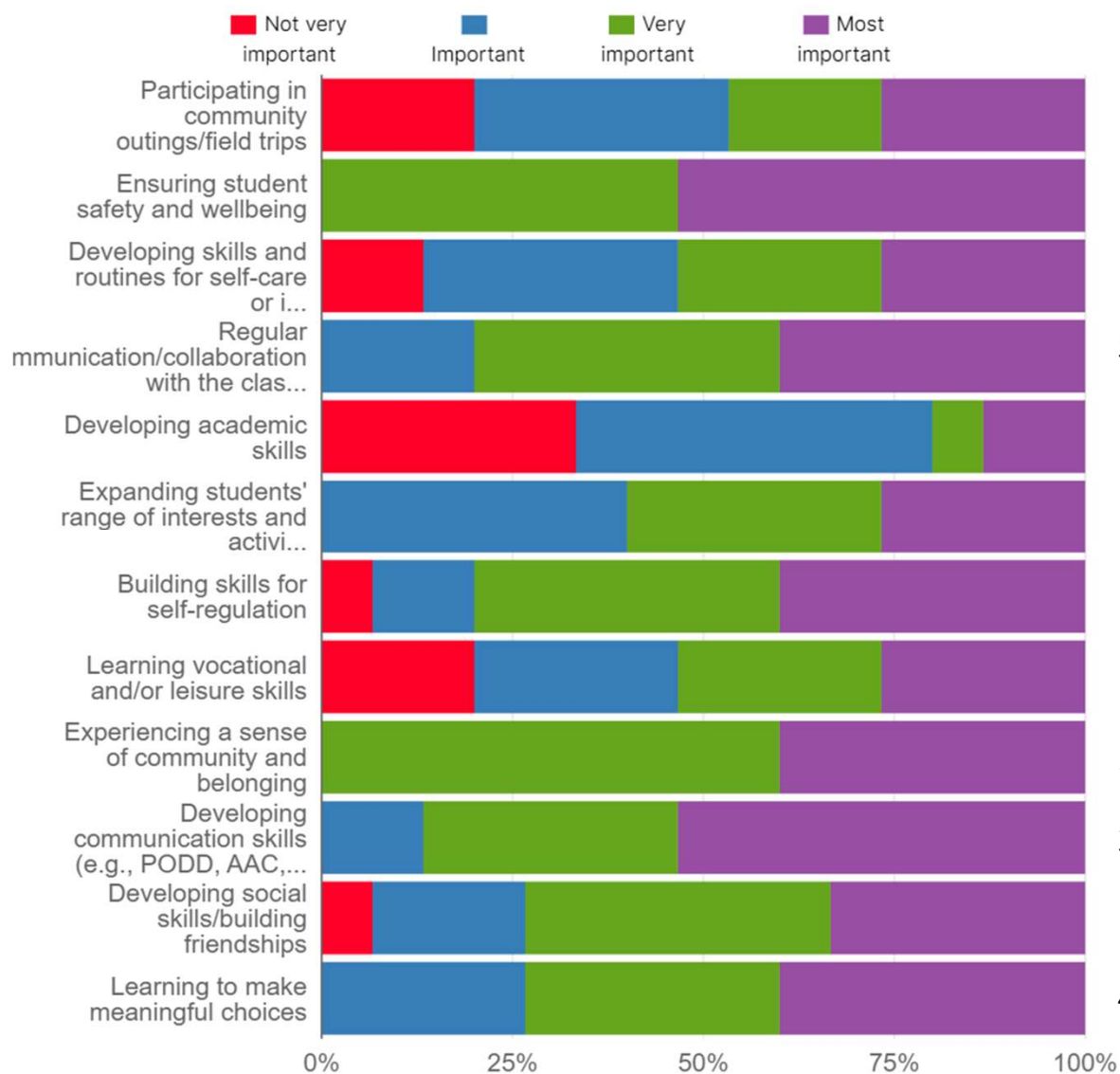

That there is a balance of each area discussed always considering the child's ability and degree of delay.

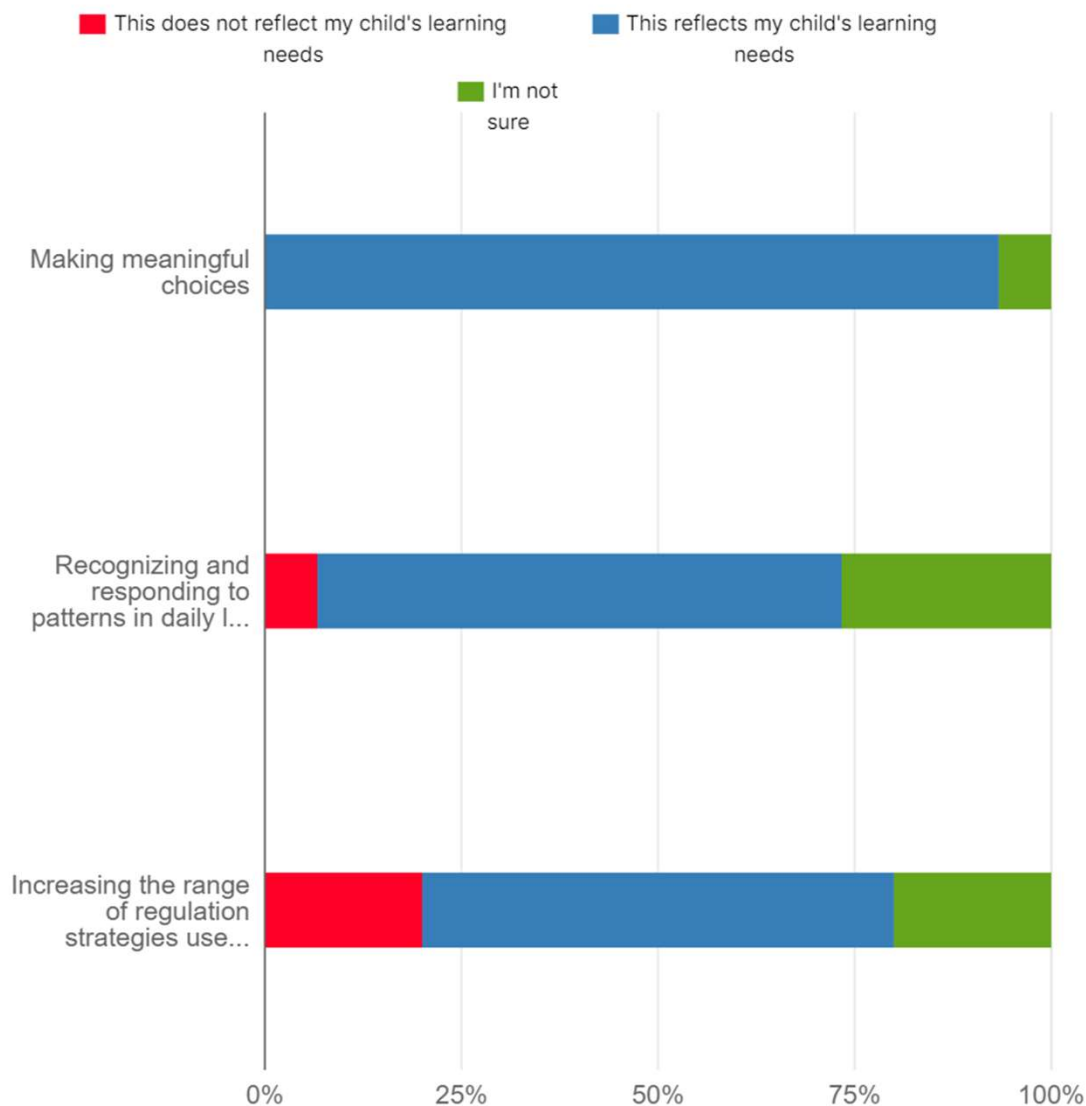
Regular communication with parent and bringing home the tools learned at school by including/showing parents so they can also ensure consistency with skills and tools used at school

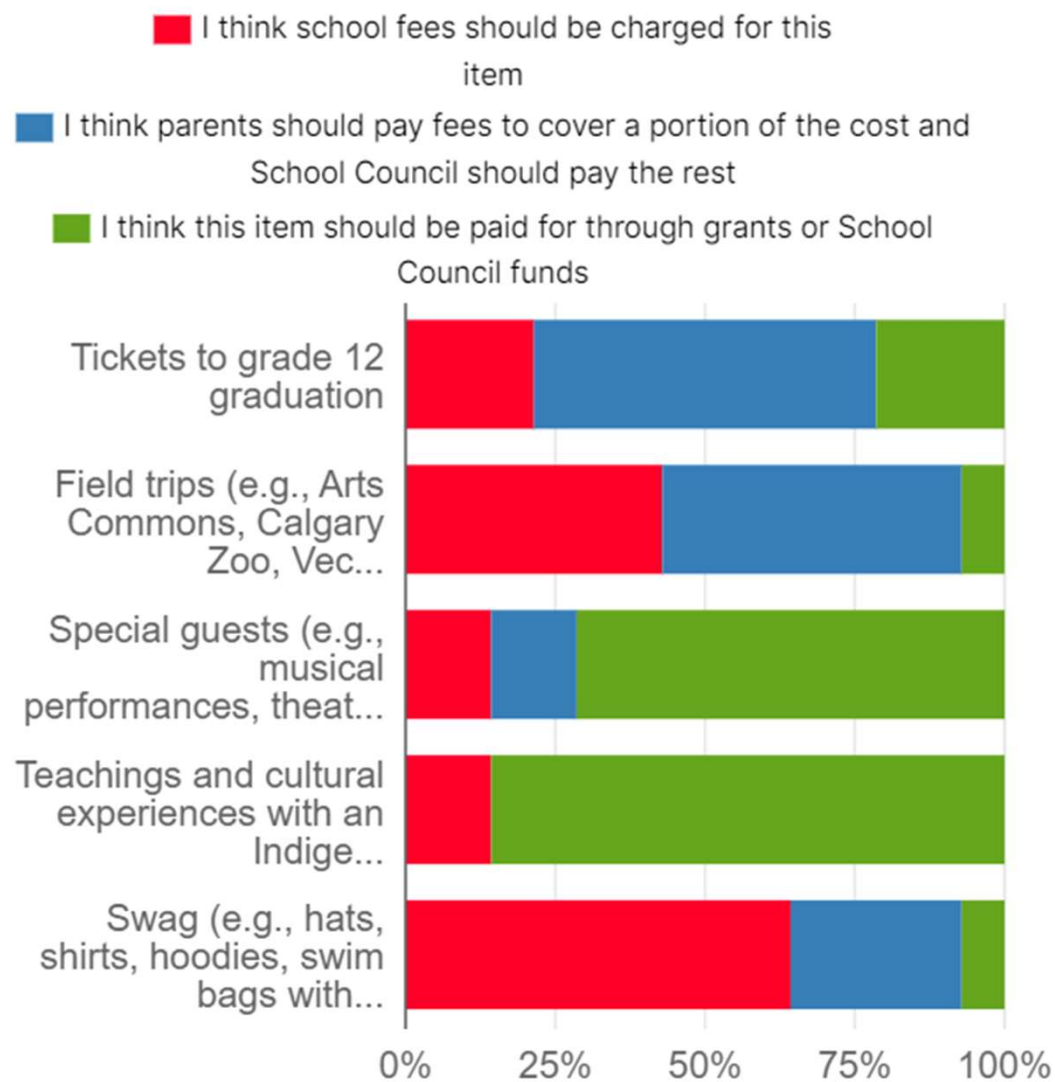


To what extent do the goals of our School Development Plan reflect your child's learning needs?
